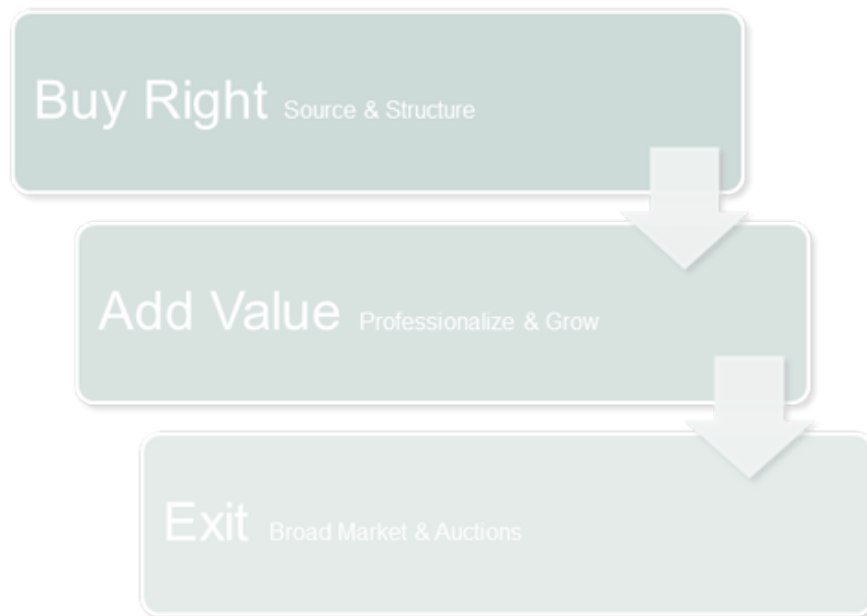

Strategy

Our strategy is to capture the return potential resident within the North American small-cap private equity market through select direct co-investments, secondary investments, and primary fund investments.



We seek to generate long-term capital gains by investing in, and alongside, a diversified group of specialized, operationally-focused buyout funds and fundless sponsors targeting private companies with enterprise values generally under \$100 million and cash flow under \$10 million. The smaller end of the North American private equity market provides investors with some of the most persistently compelling characteristics of any segment of the alternatives market.

1. **Buy Right.** Vast supply of small, private companies (>180,000) available at reasonable prices through negotiated, non-auction sale processes for the universe of small-cap buyout funds (approx. 500 small-cap funds).
2. **Add Value.** Small companies offer multiple avenues for rapid value creation, such as support with strategic acquisitions, internal controls development, lean manufacturing, and marketing strategy/initiatives.
3. **Exit.** Numerous exit avenues via auction processes comprised of middle-market private equity funds and strategic acquirers.



Investment Criteria

747 Capital seeks to meet with every small-cap buyout fund in its market. The typical small-cap buyout fund targeted by 747 Capital will have the following characteristics:

- \$50 – 350 million in LP capital
- Geographic focus on the United States and/or Canada
- Experienced investment professionals with a relevant, verifiable track record together
- Growth, buyout, or turnaround investment style
- Focus on cash flow positive companies with \$10 – 100 million in enterprise value
- Conservative use of leverage in transactions
- Track-record of control-oriented, or significant minority, investments

- Proven ability to consistently and meaningfully unlock value in portfolio companies
